

TIMELINES THE COUNTERCULTURE GODDESS

These timelines are designed as a handy reference for readers who wish to reflect on the story and perhaps discuss it in a reading club meeting. Readers should remember that the timelines only outline the story's basic structure and themes. There is much that happens regarding motives and reactions. They also contain SPOILERS.

Locations: Amsterdam, Holland – Middelburg, provincial capital of the Province of Zeeland – London city and Chiswick, a suburb of London.

1956

Chapter 1- Discovering the goddess

Eight-year-old Anneke becomes aware of Gerda staring at her – mocks and pulls faces when she sees her – otherwise does not think of her – Protestant Gerda is infuriated with the pretty Catholic girl and her mockery –

1958- 1959

Gerda's deep interest in the goddess is related – Gerda (13 years) learns about her father's occultist interests and the origin of her name – she develops (14 years) her own goddess belief with accompanying mythologies – by her fifteenth year, Gerda's goddess beliefs are fully developed – she joins the Girls Guides to be with girls and avoid boys and at the same time to proselytize her goddess beliefs – encounters Anneke and her pretty friend Nienke – Anneke begins her open mockery of Gerda and her beliefs.

1960

Chapter 2 – The Clash

Anneke's mockery comes to a head, predicted by Nienke when Anneke clashes with Gerda while on a Girl Guide walk around Walcheren's dunes – Anneke continues to taunt Gerda and on another excursion around the dunes, she antagonizes Gerda so much that Gerda assaults her – Gerda expelled from Girl Guides – Marijke guesses what happened and reprimands Anneke – Anneke regrets her action but in time gets over it – Gerda's father sets up association Companions of Creation for Gerda.

Oct. 1960 – Anneke's uncle, Fr Jos, arrives in Middelburg – speaks with Gerda's mother Truus on Marktplein – Gerda, who is nearby, frightens Anneke with a hostile gesture – Fr. Jos chats with Anneke about charity – Anneke doesn't take much notice.

1962

Chapter 3 – Gerda meets Jannie

Anneke and Nienke attend another excursion along the dunes organised by Gerda's Companions of Creation – Gerda now has a group of boys and girls around her – terse exchanges between Gerda and Anneke – Jannie de Kam unexpectedly appears – Gerda invites her to join the excursion – Anneke thinks Jannie has worries and invites her home – Jannie visits and reveals she has a particular worry – also reveals Gerda has invited her to tour Walcheren and attend the midsummer solstice – Marijke talks to Jannie about her 'problem' – no success.

Anneke is concerned about Jannie's connection with Gerda and warns Jannie – Jannie laughs off the warning – Frans tells Anneke not to get involved with Jannie and Gerda's business.

Chapter 4 – Jannie's tour

Gerda takes Jannie on a tour around Walcheren's nature reserve, gradually unfolding her vision of the goddess as connected with the physical environment – Gerda indoctrinates Jannie into the goddess – Jannie responds to Gerda's overtures of friendship.

Chapter 5 – The Summer Solstice

Jannie enjoys the celebration of the divine feminine with Gerda and her friends – joins enthusiastically in the rituals – a day later, to Gerda's horror, she finds Jannie has left Middelburg – she's in state of madness – she suspects Anneke has something to do with it and confronts her – Nienke persuades Gerda that Anneke has nothing to do with Jannie's disappearance and warns her about threats of violence – Jannie has been to a talk about the Second Vatican Council in Den Bosch given by Fr. De Jonge – returns to Middelburg to reassure Gerda – Jannie leaves Holland with the promise to write to Anneke when she's back in Australia.

1963

Chapter 6 – Anneke's bargain

Summer - Anneke and Nienke develop and begin to attract male attention – Anneke likes it, but it irks Nienke – Anneke is preoccupied with social developments – music, etc. – in September, Gerda, 18 years, begins university in Amsterdam.

1964

Anneke turns 16 – to encourage Anneke to focus on more serious things, like her schoolwork, Marijke makes a bargain – if Anneke concentrates on her English lessons, she will take her on an educational trip to England in 1965 – Nienke receives permission to go with her.

1965

Mar – Marijke is satisfied Anneke has kept to her bargain and studied and schedules the trip for early August 1965.

Chapter 7 – England surprises

Aug (early) – Marijke and girls go to London – they meet James Williamson who works in his mother's bed and breakfast at Chiswick – while touring the fashion shops they come across Jannie and Gerda at Mary Quant's shop – Jannie takes the girls on a tour of Carnaby Street – buys clothes for them – Anneke has a nasty clash with Gerda – Jannie rushes off to prepare to return to Holland – Anneke is unhappy about James's (perceived) attention to Nienke.

Chapter 8 – Anneke sulks

James takes Marijke and the girls on a tour of Dickens's London – they learn more about James – had a girlfriend – Anneke continues to be a nuisance – James tells of his commando father who was killed in a commando assault on Walcheren – the girls are curious about Ruth, a girl James brings home – James says it's a study friend.

On the final day, Anneke and Nienke go by themselves into the city – Anneke has a bad experience with boys who stalk them – Gerda turns up to gloat over Anneke's upset – James meets them at midday – consoles Anneke – James accompanies them to the ferry at Dover.

Chapter 9 – Reflections and Gerda

Without her knowing it, James's preference is for Anneke – Anneke gets over her ill-temper – Marijke mentions Jannie still has problems – Frans discusses decline in Dutch society – Rolling Stones concert riot – on her mother's insistence, Anneke writes a letter to James, thanking him for his hospitality – invites him to Middelburg on behalf of the family.

Frans mentions Gerda back in town – Gerda confronts and threatens Anneke over Jannie – appeals to Nienke to submit to the divine feminine and join the struggle against the patriarchy – Frans warns Anneke about the radical *Provos* in Amsterdam

1966

Chapter 10 – James visits Middelburg

March 1966 – Dutch Catechism released –

July – James visits Middelburg – meets the family – Anneke still ill-tempered – consumed by jealousy – Frans discusses events in the Church – James flirts with Anneke – Anneke softens –

James talks about his family background and his father's death in the war – goes to see his grave at Vlissingen – tells the romantic story of how his parents met – Frans gives an account of the commando raid on Vlissingen in which James's father was killed.

[Wounded Heart seminary closed in September – seminarians moved to Amsterdam]

Chapter 11 – James's convict ancestors

James is shown around the historical sights of Middelburg – James and the two girls tour Walcheren – Anneke is still irritating – James wonders how he could like someone with that sort of personality – Frans talks about the damaging changes brought on by Vatican II – talks about the Dutch Catechism.

James talks about his convict ancestors – he discusses his master's thesis on Great Expectations and why it is significant to him – and mentions his plans to visit his family in Australia.

Clashes of jealousy continue between Anneke and Nienke – Gerda greets James and Van Engelen family in Middelburg while they were having coffee on the square – Gerda deliberately antagonises Anneke.

Anneke is furious that James knows Gerda – James has no idea what's possessing Anneke over Gerda – Jannie is also in Middelburg with Gerda – James makes an indirect admission he's interested in Anneke.

On the final day of James's visit, Anneke makes a clumsy attempt to make James jealous. James departs, not knowing how Anneke feels about him.

August – He writes a letter saying he intends to visit his family in Australia. Anneke and Nienke are surprised – Marijke advises Anneke to write in return if she's interested in James – she should show she's interested.

Chapter 12 – In Amsterdam

August (late) – Anneke and Nienke move to Amsterdam to start their university studies – they're accommodated in a house south of central Amsterdam - attend Saturday social nights organised for Catholics from the provinces.

December (early) – Anneke's parents visit – Marijke has a 'lovely' letter from James, a group letter to Anneke, Nienke and family – Nienke and Marijke says James is interested in her and she should respond.

Frans warns her not to play with James's feelings – a man of 23 is looking for a partner – Nienke appreciates Frans's advice and declares she's looking for a candidate for marriage.

Anneke writes and receives an immediate response from James – she finally admits it's her he's interested in.

1967

January – Anneke plans to respond to his letters – calculates writing once a month, but does not expect James to write until after he has settled into his teaching job.

Chapter 13 – Wolter and Luuk

Jan (late) Corrie, the organiser of the social evenings, introduces 22-year-old Wolter Langbroek and Luuk Rietveld to Anneke and Nienke.

Wolter is in the final year of a business degree course – Luuk began university in September 1966 – worked for 1 year in father's business – spent 2 years in a major seminary in Noord Brabant – he enrolls at Amsterdam University in political science – he sparks fussy Nienke's interest to Anneke's surprise, but he is slow to respond.

Feb (mid) – Wolter and Luuk appear a second time – they make a connection with the girls – Anneke suggests a time to meet outside the meetings.

Chapter 14 – The seminarians

Feb (end) Wolter and Luuk do not appear at the next meeting – instead, two third-year seminarians, Bas Thiessen and Mark Slofstra, join the social club – Anneke clashes with Bas.

Mar (mid) – Bas and Mark attend their second social, but this time with a third seminarian, Bram de Leeuw – handsome Bram draws the attention of the girls – Wolter and Luuk appear.

Mar (mid) Nienke, Anneke, Wolter, Luuk arrange to meet on Leidseplein – Nienke admits she likes Luuk.

Chapter 15 – Relationships develop

26 Mar –Easter Sunday – Nienke and Anneke meet Wolter and Luuk in a café on Leidseplein – Nienke reaches out to Luuk, who, as usual, is grumpy – Luuk suffers from the glooms.

Gerda and bohemian friends enter the café – Gerda approaches Anneke and friends before they can leave – turns out Luuk had a clash with Gerda over the goddess – Gerda mentions James and boasts of her lover's relationship with Jannie – Gerda spits in Luuk's face – Anneke is deeply upset and comforted by Wolter – Nienke tells the origin of Gerda's hatred for Anneke.

Wolter recounts the clash Luuk had with Gerda during one of her talks – called her ideas nonsense – female nonsense – Nienke challenges him – Luuk says he's sorry Gerda coupled Nienke with him – Nienke said his glooms did not bother her.

Chapter 16 - Nienke

[Nienke's PVO]

1 April Saturday – Luuk arrives late without Wolter at the meeting – Wolter had to go home for a family occasion – Luuk and fastidious Nienke get to know each other – come to an understanding – they declare they like each other – they are prepared to see how the relationship develops.

Chapter 17 – Nienke and Luuk

8 April Saturday – Wolter arrives without Luuk – Luuk has gone to Breda – Nienke hurt – seminarian Bas attempts to explain Luuk's strange behaviour – he asserts Luuk suffers from a psychological deficit like autism.

15 April Saturday – Wolter arrives at Anneke and Nienke's accommodation with news that Luuk has again escaped to Breda – Luuk admits his behaviour had been insulting and promised to set things right.

17 April Monday – Wolter tells Nienke that Mevrouw Rietveld wants to meet her.

19 April Wednesday – Mevrouw Rietveld meets Nienke and Anneke in Amsterdam to hear the details of Luuk's abrupt flight from Nienke – promises to help Luuk understand – seems to have a plan – she explains Luuk may still feel he has a religious calling – maybe plans to go on as a religious in the community, similar to strict Opus Dei – Nienke is alarmed and disappointed.

21 April Friday – Luuk is waiting for Nienke after the morning classes – apologises for his behaviour – reveals his religious intentions before he met Nienke – Nienke changed that – he could not reconcile his religious ambitions with his liking for Nienke – caused emotional confusion – Nienke encourages him to accept their platonic relationship – Luuk agrees.

Chapter 18 – The cosmic priesthood

22 April Saturday – Luuk and Wolter come to the meeting – Luuk apologises to the gathering for his rudeness to Nienke – Nienke announces Luuk is her boyfriend – Wolter makes a declaration to Anneke about love – Bas invites Luuk and Anneke to meet a priest about Vatican II (30 April) – Wolter kisses Anneke after she gives the signal – Nienke reflects on how things have turned out with Luuk.

The foursome avoid the Saturday meetings and spend their time in Amsterdam – Luuk suggests a weekend in Breda, so Nienke and Anneke can meet their parents – Nienke likes the plan.

30 April Sunday – Nienke and Luuk arrive at the seminarians' house in Amsterdam-Zuid, where they meet the priest and his partner, who talk about a cosmic female-male priesthood – references to the goddess – there is a violent clash of ideas.

Chapter 19 – Sister McGuigan

30 April Sunday – Gerda and Sister Margaret arrive – Bas explains their connection with him – Gerda is conciliatory – she wants a better relationship with Anneke and Nienke and invites them to attend the summer solstice meeting in Zeeland – there is a further clash between the priest, Margaret and Luuk – Margaret and Gerda want Nienke to seek her true feminine destiny as a leader of young women – Margaret invites Nienke to fulfil the practical part of her course in one of the order's schools in Sydney or Melbourne – Luuk is suspicious of Margaret's motives.

Nienke asks Luuk why he avoids physical contact with her – he explains that touching her feels like a desecration – Nienke gives him permission to touch her.

The foursome meet on Leidseplein to tell about the meeting and discuss Gerda's invitation to the summer solstice – Anneke is reluctant to go – Nienke wants to know more and urges Anneke to accept the invitation/

Chapter 20 – A reconciliation

The four organise a weekend in Breda – 13-14 May – so the girls can meet the boys' parents – Nienke wants Luuk's parents to accommodate herself and Anneke – Wolter complains about lack of trust – the girls write to their parents about the scheme – Marijke rings and questions Anneke about James – Anneke says she likes Wolter a lot but still likes James – Marijke wants her to tell James if the relationship becomes steady.

5 May Friday – Nienke and Anneke receive an unexpected message to attend the Saturday meeting.

6 May Saturday – Anneke nervous – Bas turns up with Margaret and Gerda – prompted by Jannie, Gerda offers the hand of friendship to bemused Anneke – Anneke urged to accept – Anneke accepts whereupon Gerda invites her to celebrate the summer solstice on Walcheren – Nienke accepts, wanting to know what it's about and what object Gerda and Margaret have – the meeting finishes to the satisfaction of Margaret – Nienke and Anneke discuss the meeting.

10 May Wednesday – Luuk is waiting for Nienke outside the university in Spui square – tells his mother will be in Amsterdam on Friday and will drive them to Breda.

Chapter 21 - Breda

13 May Saturday – Mevrouw Rietveld picks up the foursome and reveals information about the family – discuss end of academic year – Wolter must look around for a job in finance – will have a car when he gets a job – they discuss holiday work – Wolter and Luuk have worked for Luuk's father and will do so during summer holiday – Anneke and Nienke will look for work in tourism – arrange to have a holiday together in Zeeland.

Anneke and Nienke are taken to their room at the Rietvelds – boys forbidden to go near it – Meneer Rietveld says if Nienke can't cure Luuk's psychological problems nobody can – they

learn more about both families – Anneke frustrated because she cannot have a chance to kiss Wolter.

Plans made to visit the city centre before and after lunch – first visit to fashion shops – afternoon visit to the historical places in the city – Wolter’s sister Heleen comes with them to describe the historical sights – Wolter and Anneke try to find a place to be alone in Breda park but fail – Luuk mocks Wolter.

Chapter 22 – Wolter and Roy

Nienke warns Anneke about her eagerness to find an opportunity to kiss Wolter – brings up the subject of James – Anneke airily waves the subject aside – Anneke puts on her best to go to the restaurant in the city with Luuk and Wolters’ parents – Anneke’s deliberately beguiling behaviour renders Wolter utterly smitten – parents approve – Wolter fails to find a chance to kiss Anneke – Luuk and Nienke have their first gentle kiss in the Rietveld car.

14 May Sunday – Nienke and Luuk have another opportunity to have a kiss after Mass – a moving, engaging kiss causing arousal in both – Nienke and Luuk discuss Luuk’s problem – Mevrouw having seen the mature kiss asks to speak to Nienke alone – to encourage the relationship and help Luuk get over his problems with touching Nienke, Mevrouw Rietveld suggests Nienke seduce Luuk and have a baby with him – Nienke appalled but eventually says she will reflect on it – Mevrouw Langbroek allows Wolter to drive the foursome back to Amsterdam.

Anneke and Nienke have a long discussion about what’s involved in ‘petting and caressing’ – Nienke’s arousal after Luuk’s kiss motivates her interest – Nienke is shocked by Anneke’s sexual experience – wonders how things might develop with Luuk if Luuk overcomes his problem – would she behave the same way? – Nienke asks Anneke about her relationship with James and receives the same airy response – she refuses to tell James about Wolter – the foursome agree to have a break until the summer holidays so they can concentrate on their studies.

Chapter 23 – Reflections

19 May Friday – Wolter meets Luuk to discuss his future with Anneke – Wolter is still affected by the breakup with his former girlfriend Katja van Amstel – her betrayal destroyed his trust in females – he receives a message that his parents will be in Amsterdam on Friday, 26 May, and his mother wanted to have lunch with both of them.

26 May Friday – at lunch in Amsterdam, Mevrouw Langbroek informs Wolter that Katja van Amstel has finished university in London and will return to Holland to settle in Amsterdam, where she has a job with an International Cosmetic company – she wants to see Wolter – Wolter is still furious with her and at first refuses to see her – says he would think about it – Luuk and Mevrouw Langbroek will be present.

30 May Tuesday – Message from Mevrouw Langbroek – change of plan – Katja to see Wolter
 Friday 3 June – Katja’s mother will not be present – Luuk allowed to attend.

Chapter 24 – Katja van Amstel

2 June Friday – Luuk and Wolter meet Katja van Amstel at a restaurant on Rembrandtplein – Katja dressed in a business suit, self-assured as always – inquires what Luuk and Wolter have done over three years – hears about Nienke and Anneke.

Katja asks Luuk to leave them to talk privately – unoffended Luuk returns home – Wolter listens tensely to Katja’s explanation of why she fled to London – she felt suffocated by her relationship with Wolter – she had the chance to go to London with his friend Lars to study there – she took it – did not mean to break with Wolter but it happened because Wolter was too angry to talk to her – had casual work in fashion and cosmetics – did well and was offered a job with an international cosmetic company established in Amsterdam – after hearing Katja’s explanation Wolter had the feeling he may have acted stupidly.

3 June Saturday – He rings his mother to check whether Katja is telling the truth – did she know that Katja did not mean to break with him, and there was no relationship with Lars? – his mother always believed that Katja ran off with Lars and ended the relationship.

5 June Monday - Wolter speaks to Luuk, who says there is not enough evidence to support one of two scenarios, but Wolter should be on alert to what Katja does.

Chapter 25 – Wolter’s surprise

9 June Friday – in anticipation of finishing his degree course, Wolter compiles a list of companies to apply to – Friday received a letter from his mother, plus an excellent reference from Meneer van Amstel – what does it mean regarding Katja? – rings mother for clarification

10 Jun Sat – Wolter’s mother rings with a message from Teun van Amstel to choose tech companies

12 Jun Mon – Wolter shows Luuk five lots of applications

14 Jun Weds – Wolter receives 3 phone calls to ring regarding job applications – makes appointments for the following day.

15 Jun Thurs – Attends interviews – impressions good – makes appointment to see Anneke and Nienke.

16 Jun Fri – he visits Anneke and Nienke to make arrangements for Summer Solstice – Wolter tells Anneke of job interviews.

19 Jun Mon – Wolter requested to ring Mr Sullivan of the most favourable tech company – Wolter offered a job – discusses job with Luuk – decides to take the job – discusses possible connections with Katja.

20 Jun Tues – Wolter receives contract forms to sign – signs the forms and takes Luuk out to celebrate.

21 Jun Weds – Anneke receives a letter from James – James is suffering from a concussion after falling over, but Nienke finds the details vague.

23 Jun Fri – Foursome arrive in Breda – Wolter and Luuk are surprised with cars – minis – gifts from their parents.

Chapter 26 – The Middelburg family

24 Jun Sat – Luuk discusses his unease and anxiety about Nienke with his mother – he is urged to persevere – Luuk’s mother remarks on Anneke’s flightiness – Nienke makes arrangements to go on to Middelburg after an early lunch.

Mevrouw Rietveld has a chat with Nienke – observes that Luuk is less anxious – Nienke is patient, but is patience enough? – she suggests again the seduction way – Nienke declares she can’t do anything so deceitful – Mevrouw explains the rhythm method to calculate when a woman is fertile.

Wolter and Anneke arrive in Middelburg – Anneke says she’s nervous because of family – says she must be less open – but she’s worried about the underlying role of James, which all her family are aware of.

Wolter well received by the family – unusually Frans takes to him – mention of his job – Marijke inquires about his literary interest – Wolter had none to speak of – speaks of renting flat in Amsterdam – Joop inquires if Anneke is his girlfriend – Wolter completely unaware of James says yes – his family loves Anneke – they think she’s the queen of heats which amuses the van Engelen family – Wolter unaware of the amusement of Anneke’s brothers.

Nienke and Luuk arrive – discuss the castle and the nature of the solstice ceremony – pagan – Frans and Marijke disturbed, but Anneke says she has no interest in the goddess. It’s Nienke that curious.

Chapter 27 – The summer solstice

24 June – Saturday – The foursome arrive at the castle around the same time as Katja, Liesje (Katja’s boss), Gerda, Jannie and Margaret – Liesje talks about Nienke and Anneke’s potential as models – talks about having casual work for the girls in Amsterdam – plans to make an appointment – Katja pretends she sees Wolter for the first time since arriving back in Holland – Wolter doesn’t tell Anneke the full truth only mentioning Katja was a former girlfriend – Luuk suggests Katja might be scheming to reignite relationship – Katja annoys Anneke.

Discussion about Nienke’s and Anneke’s beauty – Margaret exhibits a liking for Nienke – Nienke says her idea of the goddess does not accord with Catholic teaching – Margaret offends Nienke by referring to Luuk as a misogynist, and apologises.

Gerda appears to be the leader of the group of 30 women – she addresses the group talking about the new beginnings the solstice signifies – invites Margaret to address the group – talk of authentic female ecumenism in the goddess – proposes to lead the group through meditations on the inner goddess – searching the inner self produces a hall of weeping women – Anneke and Nienke find it amusing – after ridding themselves of their individual burdens they return outside where flaming torches line the path to the dunes. There are tables with food and drink around a bonfire.

Wolter is bored out of his mind – Luuk wonders what the girls are doing – Wolter reflects on the influence Luuk has had on Nienke.

Anneke is bored with the dances and singing that help plumb the depths of the goddess in the inner self and wants to go home – Margaret approaches Nienke again – Nienke again questions the connection between the goddess and Catholicism – Margaret is alarmed to hear that Nienke and Anneke want to leave – prevails on them to wait for the communal hug.

Liesje and Katja join the girls, forcing Margaret to withdraw – Liesje talks about work in a department store – appeals to Nienke – Margaret is again alarmed that Nienke may turn her back on teaching – the communal hug interrupts their conversation. Nienke and Anneke are assaulted in the hug – Jannie, Liesje and Katja are concerned.

In the meantime, Luuk, worried about the girls, goes to a spot in the forest below the dunes to see what's going on – Wolter follows him – when they discover where they are, they witness the upheaval in the communal hug – Luuk sends Wolter back to the car and approaches the group of women.

Margaret is outraged by the presence of a male – Gerda calls the guards, but Luuk warns them off – Jannie and her group are sorry to see the girls go – Liesje accompanies them to their car and fetches brochures about her company's product for Nienke – Liesje asks Nienke to ring to make an appointment in Amsterdam.

Wolter consoles Anneke – Nienke will talk to Luuk about it later – returning to Middelburg, Anneke tells Nienke she was assaulted twice – they decide not to tell Wolter – but Nienke says Luuk will want to know – she tells him – Luuk says he supports Nienke in her interest in Liesje's offer.

Chapter 28 - Reflections

25 June – Sunday – Nienke reflects on the weekend – pleased that her family greeted Luuk warmly and Luuk was at ease among them – they discuss getting married – Nienke keen but Luuk wants to wait until he can overcome his problem – they decide to wait until the end of the academic year before seeing each other again.

Anneke reflects on the weekend – irritated she had little chance to be alone with Wolter – irked that the family accepted him so warmly – Wolter unaware of the undercurrent of James Williamson – Anneke wants to know about Katja, which irritates Wolter – says he wouldn't ask

her about her past boyfriends – she should not ask about his – Anneke gives in but continues to wonder about Katja.

Nienke and Anneke receive an invitation to dinner with Jannie – suspect it's about the assaults – she apologises for the assaults – blames Gerda – explains women in the goddess movement don't mind being touched by other women.

Jannie explains what a model does – the girls are suitable – are they interested? – they are – Jannie invites them to a makeup session at the Department Store.

Chapter 29 - Modelling

Anneke and Nienke attend the makeup session but find themselves drawn into taking a part – they are a success – offered work at the department store and listing with a model agency – they accept – Anneke and Nienke's parents have no objections.

Chapter 30 – Luuk and Nienke

15 July – Saturday – academic year ended – portfolio photos taken for modelling work – the foursome go on a trip to Zandvoort in both minis – Anneke wants to be alone with Wolter – Luuk speaks about his difficulty but reassured by Nienke – speaks about his labouring work – likes the contemplation – talks about seminary influence – offers to take Nienke to the seminary – speaks about his contemplation – compares New Testament God to the goddess – speaks about Margaret's interest in Nienke – refers to Anneke and Wolter's weak faith – Nienke wants to share her faith with Luuk – they arrange to go to Mass together.

26 Oct – Thurs – Wolter is rung by Roy Clark – he invites Wolter and Luuk to attend a talk by Ronnie Newell – that will give him a chance to chat to Luuk – Luuk is agreeable – intended to return to Amsterdam, anyhow.

28 Oct – Sat – they meet for a coffee beforehand – Luuk plays cat and mouse with Roy, probing his role as a possible CIA officer – Roy admits nothing – at the meeting, Roy mysteriously approaches one of Ronnie’s retinue who wears an Akubra – Ronnie gives his usual speech – Luuk mocks him and his crowd – radical students order him out – Luuk is beaten up and left bleeding on the pavement outside the venue.
